### 3rd Conditional (Past, past):

1. If I had known, I would have gone.
  - a. If I'd known, I'd have gone.
2. If I'd eaten the fish, I'd have been sick.

### 4th Conditional (temporally mixed):

1. Conditional Past, hypothetical Present:
  - a. If Mexico had won the war, we would all be eating tacos.
2. Conditional past, hypothetical future:
  - a. If you had applied to medical school, you would become a doctor someday.
3. Conditional present, hypothetical past.
  - a. If I were a happy person, I would have smiled yesterday.
4. Conditional present, hypothetical future.
  - a. If I had a horse, I would enter tomorrow's race.
5. Conditional future, hypothetical past.
  - a. If it wasn't raining this weekend, I would have sold my umbrella.
6. Conditional future, hypothetical present.
  - a. If I was traveling this weekend, I'd be so happy right now.

Advanced conditionals:

1. Unless it rains, we will play soccer.
2. We'll play soccer even if it rains!
  - a. We'll play soccer no matter what.
3. Close the freezer, otherwise the ice will melt.
4. Had I known, I would have behaved differently.
5. If it weren't for my friend, I would have been late.
